\*All fees listed above are inclusive of VAT (with the exception of Nursery school fees, which are VAT-exempt).

Our fees INCLUDE a hot home-made lunch (salad and vegetarian alternatives available) and most excursions during the school day (but not residential trips).

A deposit of £3,000 is payable upon acceptance of a place at the school. This is returned when the child leaves the school, subject to the school having received payment of all sums due to it, including fees in lieu of notice where required.

#### MUSIC (INDIVIDUAL LESSONS)

### GOVERNMENT SCHEMES TO HELP REDUCE FEES

#### Local Authority Grant for younger children

If your child is under 5 on 1 September, 1 January or 1 April, for the term beginning in that month you may choose to take advantage of a Local Authority Grant (otherwise known as the Minimum Funding Entitlement, Nursery Education Grant or Early Education Childcare Place funding) paid by the local authority to the school. This is attributed to a statutory maximum of 15 hours' early years education per week. To cover contracted hours in excess of this statutory maximum, parents in receipt of the grant pay the difference between the amount of the grant and the school fees stated above. The grant is £1,300.65 for the Autumn Term 2026.

#### Childcare vouchers and Tax-free childcare

The school accepts most companies' childcare vouchers. It also accepts payments under the government's tax-free childcare scheme. Childcare vouchers can be used to pay fees prior to a child reaching the compulsory school age of 5. They can also be used to pay for wraparound care and before and after school clubs.
